Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Sameer Verma, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Model Town Jalandhar on behalf of respondent No.1 filed. Wherein he has contended that petitioner – Nirmal Singh is father of Gangandeep Singh, who is a drug addict and is involved in FIR No.101 dated 16.05.2013 under Sections 27/61 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar as well as in FIR No.97 dated 23.06.2014 under Sections 21/27 of NDPS Act 1985 registered with Police Station Bhargo Camp, Jalandhar; that the petitioner has filed the petition on wrong and baseless facts; that actually on 29.10.2017 Gagandeep Singh was found in possession of two grams of Smack by ASI Balkar Singh of Police Station

of Division No.7, Jalandhar apprehended in the area of railway crossing of village Subhana, subsequently, he was released on bail; the allegations regarding Gagandeep Singh having been lifted on 27.10.2017 at about 2:30 p.m. / 3:00 p.m are denied stating that it has been put forward to create false evidence of alibi.

In view of the contentions in the reply, no further action on the communication sent by the petitioner by post is called for. The petitioner is at liberty to take recourse of any remedy available to him under the law under the given circumstances.

The present petition stands dismissed.
