The instant writ petition has been filed seeking extension in service on the basis of the policy dated 08.10.2012 (Annexure P-1)

Upon notice, the State filed reply stating that the petitioner would not be entitled to the extension in service as sought for.

At this juncture, counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant writ petition with a limited prayer that the petitioner should be paid retiral benefits as soon as possible because he superannuated on 30.04.2015 and as on date neither he has been given any extension nor have the retiral benefits been paid to him. In fact, the petitioner has only been released 90% of the GPF.

Counsel for the respondents-State, on instructions from Sh. Vijay Kumar, District Sports Office, Hoshiarpur, states that in case the petitioner submits an application within a period of two weeks from today, the pension papers and other retiral benefits will be processed within a period of two months thereafter.

In view of the very fair statement that has been made, the instant writ petition is being disposed of with a direction to the respondents-State that in case the petitioner submits the requisite application within a period of two weeks from today, the retiral benefits, as due to him, be released to him within a period of two months thereafter, failing which the same will be paid with interest @ 9% per month calculating from the date it became due, i.e. the date he superannuated, till the date the amount is paid.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
