Heard.

Present habeas corpus petition has been filed by the petitioner for release of his daughter Kiranjit Kaur (detenue), who is stated to be in illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the copy of the order dated 07.11.2017 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.41993 of 2017 (protection petition) filed by the detenue and respondent No.4 Gurjeet Singh, wherein it was recorded that the present petitioner was present in the Court and in his presence his daughter was questioned, who was four days short of attaining the age of majority, to which she has insisted that she had married petitioner No.2 (respondent No.4 in the present petition) of her own.

It also comes out that an FIR has been registered against

respondent No.4.

Keeping in view the order passed by this Court in CRM-M No.41993 of 2017, it comes out that Kiranjit Kaur (detenue), who was four days short of attaining the age of majority, had married petitioner No.2 of her own. Therefore, it is not a case of illegal detention.

As such, the present petition is dismissed.
