Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 (2-A) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release), Act, 1988 is for extension of prole for a further period of four weeks as the petitioner is medically unfit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is suffering from acute PIVD with PUO (Dengue) and for the said purpose, he requires proper treatment.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of reply by way of affidavit Hardeep Singh PPS, Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur, filed today, which has been taken on record, submitted that the petitioner is suffering from dengue fever and is getting proper medical treatment.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is suffering from dengue fever and there is no such ailment which requires release of the petitioner on parole.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
