The complaint was received by post with the allegations that the son of the complainant/ petitioner was involved in the business of selling foot wears on a cart near Laxmi Cinema, Hoshiarpur. On 19.01.2017, son of the complainant/ petitioner found that his Discover motorcycle was stolen from the parking of the Laxmi Cinema Hotel Amber. On verification, it was found that the same was taken away by C.I.A. Staff, Bahadurpur, Hoshiarpur. On 21.01.2017, when the son of

the complainant/ petitioner went to C.I.A. Staff, the police allegedly detained him.

Notice of motion was issued to respondent-State of Punjab on 15.02.2017.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Gurjit Pal Singh, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police (Detective), Hoshiarpur, has been filed on behalf of State of Punjab and the same is taken on record. In the reply, reference has been made to the statement of the complainant/ petitioner, wherein he has stated that the complaint was filed only on account of misunderstanding. His son was allowed to take the motorcycle. The filing of the complaint was with a view to save his son from being involved in a case of gambling.

In view of the statement of the complainant/ petitioner recorded by the police on 28.01.2017, no further order is required to be passed in this case.
