The petitioner through the present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeks concession of parole in order to enable him to attend the marriage of his sister's daughter, which is fixed for 24.11.2017.

Report has been received to the effect that sister's daughter, namely Priyanka, of the petitioner is scheduled for 24.11.2017 at village Shishwala, District Charkhi Dadri.

Taking into consideration the relationship of the petitioner being maternal uncle of the girl, we are of the opinion that he can be permitted to attend and perform the requisite ceremonies by sending him in custody.

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Petition is disposed of with the direction that petitioner will attend the marriage of his sister's daughter scheduled for 24.11.2017 at village Shishwala, District Charkhi Dadri in custody on 24.11.2017. He will be taken in custody to the venue of marriage in village Shishwala, District Charkhi Dadri in the morning at his own expenses and would be taken back in the evening.
