Prayer made in the petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 (1) (b) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, is for issuance of directions to the respondents to release him on Parole for one month, so as to enable him to get his house repaired/renovate.

It is the case of the petitioner that he applied for grant of parole so as to enable him to repair/renovate his house. His application was approved by the Jail Authorities and forwarded to respondents No. 3 and 4 on 13.08.2016. However, till date no final decision has been taken by the concerned authority on his application for grant of Parole. He also submitted a representation

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dated 17.12.2016 (Annexure P-1) to the jail Superintendent for releasing him on parole but no action has been taken on the same so far.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Praveen Bhadu, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice.

A copy of the petition along with its annexure has been supplied by the learned counsel for the petitioner to the learned State counsel in the Court itself.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties but without commenting on the merits, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner/District Magistrate, Palwal to consider and decide the application filed by the petitioner for the grant of parole expeditiously, preferably, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
