Learned counsel appears on behalf of respondent No.5 and
filed vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

Respondent No.5-Dalbir Singh has brought alleged detenue Balak
Devi with him. Balak Devi states that she is aged about 22 years, as such a major
and she has got married with Dalbir Singh against wishes of her family members.
The couple has been brought to the Court by ASI Balbir Singh, Police Station
South, Moga.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 has submitted that a petition
had been filed by respondent No.5 Dalbir Singh and Balak Devi before Punjab
State Human Rights Commission and protection has been granted to them vide
order dated 03.11.2017. A copy of that order has been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that Balak Devi is a minor
and aged about 16 years, which fact is strongly refused by Balak Devi herself.

Since Balak Devi has appeared in the Court and states that she has

got married with Dalbir Singh and protection has been granted to them by Punjab State Human Rights Commission, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition granting him liberty to approach appropriate authority/Forum/Court for redressal of his grievances.

Allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
