In response to the order dated 10.01.2017, replies of the SSP, Police District Batala, the SHO, Police Station Qadian, the Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur and the SDM, Batala, are already on record.

As per the aforesaid replies, the detainee, Bhai Baljit Singh Daduwal and one Jagjit Singh, were arrested on 01.01.2017 by ASI Iqbal Singh under the supervision of the SHO, Police Station Qadian, apprehending breach of peace and therefore exercising jurisdiction under Sections 107/151 Cr.P.C. The detainees were produced before the SDM, Batala, on the same date and were sent to judicial custody till 14.01.2017 but were actually released on 06.01.2017 itself, upon an application filed by the SHO of Police Station Qadian, that there was no longer apprehension of breach of peace.

In view of the above, there was obviously no illegal detention of the detainees and consequently, this petition is dismissed.
