Both the counsel for the parties submitted that respondent-workman has attained age of superannuation and stated to be retired w.e.f. 01.01.2002 and the fact that petitioners have deposited back wages in terms of the award before the Labour Court-II, Faridabad. In view of the later development that respondent-workman has retired from service, petition do not survive for consideration. Respondent-workman is at liberty to make necessary application for releasing the deposited back wages by the petitioner. If such an application is made in accordance with law before the Labour Court, the Labour Court is hereby directed to disburse the deposited back wages along with interest earned, if any to the respondent-workman within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of such application.

Petition stands disposed of as infructuous.
