In pursuance of order dated 05.02.2017, a report dated 07.02.2017 has been submitted by the Warrant Officer disclosing that Dharam Raj @ Dharminder was found detained in the lock up and his statement was recorded. Virpal Kaur and minor children namely Nishey and Harloon Kaur were also found sitting in the visitors room of the police station. There was no case registered against Virpal Kaur and minor children. Dharminder and Des Raj are accused of FIR No.14 dated 05.02.2017 for the offence under Sections 380, 448, 34 IPC. Other alleged detainees i.e. Arjun and Ravi were not found present in the premises of the police station.

In view of aforesaid, since Virpal Kaur and minor children were not accused of any FIR and they left the premises of the police station, therefore, this petition is disposed of as no further action is required to be called for. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
