In pursuance of order dated 06.03.2017, status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Prabhjot Singh, IAS, District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Ambala has been filed stating that co-workers of the petitioner along with their family members as shown in para No.3 of the report were found present at the spot and they jointly and separately gave statements to the team on oath. As per their statements, they are working with M/s Dhani Ram and sons Brick kiln with their own free Will since January, 2017.

Petitioner was not found present at the spot as he has already gone along with his family to his native village after taking his dues from the owner. All the employees were duly

paid their dues by the owner and they were doing the work at their own free Will and had no grievance against the brick kiln owner.

In the inquiry, it was concluded that there was no labour which was illegally detained by the owner of the brick kiln. All the mandatory provisions of Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976, Inter State Migrant Workman and Employment Act, 1979 were duly complied with.

In view of the report of the Committee submitted through the affidavit of District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, no further action is required to be called for in this petition.

Petition stands disposed of.
