INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Manga, has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for grant of 6 weeks parole enabling him to attend the marriage of his son, which is scheduled for 28.12.2017.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Ms. Simranjeet Kaur, AAG, Punjab, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and admitted the factum of marriage of petitioner's son on 28.12.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has also to perform customs on the eve of marriage of his son, therefore, parole for one week may be granted.

Heard.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is granted the concession of interim bail w.e.f. 25.12.2017 to 31.12.2017, in order to enable him to attend the marriage function/ ceremonies of his son, subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Jail Authorities on 31.12.2017 at 10:00 AM sharp.

As requested, a copy of this order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Disposed of accordingly.
