Petitioner Hardev Singh has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing of the order dated 15.07.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by the District Magistrate, Amritsar.

The petitioner has been convicted on 19.08.2015 by the learned Judge, Special Court, Tarn Taran for the offences punishable under Sections 23 (c), 29 and 27 (a) of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. Vide separate order passed on the same date, he has been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 20 years separately for each of the said offences, besides, pay a fine of ₹2,00,000/- and in default thereof, undergo rigorous imprisonment for four years for each of the said offences. The sentences awarded have been ordered to run concurrently. Against the said conviction and sentence, the petitioner has filed Criminal Appeal No.D-543-DB-2016 which is pending in this Court.

The said conviction is on a complaint filed by the Intelligence Officer, Directorate of Revenue Intelligence, Sub Unit, MI/C, Green Avenue, Amritsar. The Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar as well as the Intelligence Officer, Directorate of Revenue Intelligence, Sub Unit, MI/C, Green Avenue, Amritsar have not been impleaded as a party.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, in the circumstances, prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition and file a fresh one by making necessary amendments in the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
