Petitioner-Ran Singh @ Mogi has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with the provisions of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for extension in the parole release of the petitioner for two weeks from 16.02.2017 to 29.02.2017 to enable him for attending the marriage of his brother's son in which he and his wife are the mediators.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is already on parole and his parole is going to be expired on 15.02.2017. He asked for extension of parole for two weeks w.e.f. 16.02.2017 to 29.02.2017 to

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enable him for attending the marriage of his nephew. In no way, presence of the petitioner in the marriage of his nephew can be held as essential or necessary. Therefore, no ground is made out for extension of parole of the petitioner for two weeks.

Finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
