Report dated 16th February, 2017 of Police Station Basti Jodhewal, District Ludhiana which is duly supported by the statements of the respectables and police as well as marriage invitation card, filed today in the Court. Same are taken on record.

Heard.

In the light of stand of the State in report filed before this Court, petitioner-Paramjit Singh, who is facing trial under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, for being found in illegal possession of poppy husk, has to attend marriage of Bhishan, his nephew, being son of his real elder brother Surinder Pal, which is to be solemnized on 18th February, 2017 with Anika daughter of Sarabjeet Singh, resident of

village Jandiala, District SBS Nagar at R.G. Palace, Near Railway Crossing, Mukandpur Road, Banga.

Since, the petitioner as per report happens to be the real paternal uncle, therefore, as per the prevalent customs and rituals, his presence at the time of marriage is essential.

Keeping in view that the petitioner is in custody on the allegations for being found in possession of huge contraband of poppy husk, it would be sub-serve the ends of justice, if the petitioner is granted parole for a period of 02 days with effect from today i.e. 17th and 18th February, 2017 subject to furnishing of personal bonds in the sum of ₹ 5.00 lacs with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana and the petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Jail at Ludhiana on 19th February, 2017 at 10.00 a.m.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
