Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though it has been confirmed that the petitioners' sister is to get married on 26.02.2017 and there are also ceremonies on 25.02.2017, however, the petitioner has 4 other cases also registered against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner disputes the aforesaid contention.

Keeping in view the circumstances and the fact that the marriage fixed is 3 days away, the petitioner is ordered to be released on parole for the period 24.02.2017 till 28.02.2017, upon his father and one other person standing surety for him to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate / Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana and furnishing adequate bail bonds also to the satisfaction of that Court.
