The application sent by petitioner-Baljinder Kaur, to the office of Hon'ble the Chief Justice, was taken on judicial side and was treated as Criminal Writ Petition.

It has been alleged in the application that Navkaran Singh, son of the petitioner, was arrested by the police officials, but she did not get any information from police party as to from which police station, above police officials had come.

Notice of the motion was issued and learned State counsel was directed to get the matter inquired into and to file reply.

I have heard learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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Today, reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Jatinder Singh, Inspector, S.H.O, P.S.City Malout has been filed in the Court. Same is taken on record. As per the said reply, Navkaran Singh, son of the petitioner, has been arrested in FIR No.158 dated 06.11.2016, under Sections 392, 397 and 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, P.S.City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and now he is in judicial custody. Learned State counsel also stated that son of the petitioner was arrested on 14.02.2017 in the said case.

Keeping in view the fact that Navkaran Singh has been arrested by the police in the aforesaid FIR and now he is in judicial custody, no further action is required in this petition.
