In pursuance of order dated 27.02.2017, a Committee was constituted by the District Magistrate. The committee raided the brick kiln in question. In the premises of the brick kiln, some labourers were found. Inquiry was conducted from them in respect of allegations made in para No.2 of the petition. There was no boundary wall at the brick kiln and the persons found in the premises submitted that they can move anywhere from brick kiln and they have already received their wages. They showed their unwillingness to work at the brick kiln. Statement of the brick kiln owner was also recorded who also showed his satisfaction over the work of the labourers for which they were duly paid their dues. He had no objection in

case the labourers go from the brick kiln according to own volition. Joint statements of the labourers as shown in para No.7 of the reply were also recorded. The persons/labourers wanted to leave for Jalandhar Bye Pass. A truck was arranged by the owner of the brick kiln and thereafter, the labourers left the spot.

In view of report submitted by the Committee, no further action is required to be called for.

Petition stands disposed of.
