This order will dispose of aforesaid two petitions one bearing
CRWP No. 245 of 2017 filed by Surjit Kaur seeking release of detenue

Komaljeet Kaur and second petition CRM-M-No. 2205 of 2017 filed by

petitioners Komaljeet Kaur and Sanjeev Kumar seeking quashing of FIR No. 0006 dated 02.01.2017 registered at Police Station Panipat City for the offence punishable under Section 365 of Indian Penal Code.

On the request of counsel for the parties, the matter was sent to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court where the matter has been amicably settled. Komaljeet Kaur and respondent No. 4-Sanjeev Kumar have taken blessings in this Court from petitioner-Surjit Kaur, who seeks permission to withdraw the Criminal Writ Petition No. 245 of 2017. She further submits that in view of the settlement before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, which is reduced into writing and signed by her, she has no objection if FIR No. 0006 dated 02.01.2017 for the offence punishable under Section 365 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Panipat City is quashed.

The FIR was got registered by Satinder Kaur i.e. natural mother of Komaljeet Kaur. She is also present in the Court and has signed the settlement arrived at before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, which is taken on file as Ex. C-1. Satinder Kaur has also given blessings to Komaljeet Kaur and Sanjeev Kumar and sought quashing of FIR got registered by her.

The FIR pertains to abduction of Komaljeet Kaur, who is presently living with her husband Sanjeev Kumar, who is also present in the Court.

In view of above facts, no purpose will be served by keeping the FIR got registered by Satinder Kaur, pending. It will be in the interest of petitioners as well as the complainant Satinder Kaur that the FIR be

quashed, so that petitioners Komaljeet Kaur and Sanjeev Kumar may lead their married life in a peaceful manner. The quashing of FIR will help both the parties to live amicably peacefully and for their better future.

In view of above discussion, petition bearing No. CRM-M-2205-2017 is dismissed as withdrawn.

Petition bearing No. CRM-M-2205-2017 is allowed and FIR No. 006 dated 02.01.2017, registered at Police Station Panipat City is quashed qua the petitioners.
