As already noticed in the order dated March 06, 2017, upon direction of this Court dated March 02, 2017 that District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Panchkula, had deputed the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kalka, who further had constituted a team of five officers/officials to conduct the spot inspection of the brick kiln in question on 02.03.2017 itself and upon the said team having visited the spot, the five persons who were stated to be allegedly illegally detained, whose names are given in Paragraph-4 of the petition, were found to have actually left the brick kiln on the night of 13.01.2017 i.e. about one and a half months earlier. The petitioner's sister and brother-in-law and two other persons were stated to have been found present at the spot.

The counsel for the petitioner not having been present on March 06, 2017 and the matter was adjourned till today. Today, again

counsel for the petitioner is not present.

Since, the contents of the report submitted by the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Panchkula, or that of the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kalka, (which is annexed with it), have not been refuted either on March 06, 2017 or today, this petition is disposed of as having become rendered infructuous.
