This petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, read with Section 3 of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoner (Temporary Relief) Act, 1962, praying for releasing the petitioner on parole/furlough as recommended by Superintendent, Central Jail, Jalandhar vide letter dated 06.12.2016, but respondent No.2 is not taking any decision on this matter and has kept the case of the petitioner pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer that his case for releasing the petitioner on parole/furlough may be decided expeditiously.
