Pleadings on record have been perused.

Placed on record at Annexure P-1 is a transfer order dated 19.06.2016 and in terms of which, the petitioner who was serving as an ETT Teacher had been transferred from Government Primary School, Sarota to Government Primary School, Sunder Chak, Pathankot.

Grievance raised in the instant petition was that the petitioner was not being permitted to joint duty at the transferred place/station in terms of order dated 19.06.2016 and rather another transfer order dated 25.06.2016 (Annexure P-5) was passed and in terms of which, one Smt. Radha Rani, ETT Teacher had been transferred at Government Primary School, Sunder Chak, Pathankot.

Upon notice of motion having been issued a written statement of the District Education Officer (Elementary Education),

Pathankot (Punjab), has been filed and placed on record.

In the reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, a categorical stand has been taken that permission has been granted to the petitioner to join at his transferred place i.e. Government Primary School, Sunder Chak, Pathankot, vide order dated 12.07.2016 (Annexure R-3/1) and in pursuance thereto, the petitioner has already submitted his joining report on 29.07.2016 and is currently serving as ETT Teacher at Government Primary School, Sunder Chak, Pathankot.

In the light of such categorical stand taken in the written statement, nothing would survive in the instant petition and the same is disposed of having rendered infructuous.
