Petitioner-Sarabjit Kaur has filed this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus by appointing Warrant Officer to release the detenues namely Sukhbir Kaur, Harminder Singh and Ram Singh, who are allegedly in the illegal custody of respondent No.3.

Vide order dated 09.03.2017, Registry was directed to appoint Warrant Officer, who shall visit the place where the detenues are alleged to be detained illegally.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Now, the report of Warrant Officer has been received. As per the same, the Warrant Officer visited Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali, on 09.03.2017 at 6.10 P.M. When the Warrant Officer reached the police station, Harminder Singh and Ram Singh, alleged detenues, were

found standing on the entrance gate of the police station while taking with

Santri, who asked them to leave the police station. However, when the Warrant Officer entered into the police station, he found third detinue namely Sukhbir Kaur. On being asked, ASI Palwinder Singh disclosed that Sukhbir Kaur was arrested on 09.03.2017 vide DDR No.33 in connection with FIR No.43 dated 09.03.2017, registered under Sections 384, 447 and 511 IPC after getting conducted her medical examination from Civil Hospital, SAS Nagar, Mohali. It is also stated that Sukhbir Kaur was released on bail by the police in the presence of Warrant Officer.

Keeping in view the report of Warrant Officer, no further action is required in this petition.
