Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 31.03.2017, an affidavit of Sh. Palwinder Singh Cheema, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Divison, Barnala, has been filed in Court today by the learned State counsel, stating to the effect that even as per the school record of the place where the daughter of the petitioners was studying, her date of birth is 20.03.1999, thereby making her about three months short of the legally marriageable age for girls

On the last date of hearing, as recorded in that order, i.e. 31.03.2017, the daughter of the petitioner made a statement in the Court that she wishes to reside with her husband, Aman @ Babbu. Hence, nothing further remains to be done in the present petition, with the learned counsel for the petitioners also seen to have not appeared after 16.01.2017.

Consequently, the alleged detinue, i.e. Anuradha, being above

legally marriageable age as of today, this petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
