This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India issuing direction to respondents for grant of four weeks parole to the petitioner to meet his family members under Section 3 sub clause (1) sub clause (d) of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners Temporary Release Act 1962.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer that his application for releasing the petitioner for four weeks parole is pending since 11.07.2016 before the respondents, which may be decided expeditiously.
