The writ petitioner-Pawan has sought for parole to arrange resources to pay the fees of his children, who are studying in school.

Notice of motion.

On our asking, Mr. Kapil Aggarwal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, took notice for the respondents.

We find that Sunita Devi wife of the writ petitioner-Pawan, who is a convict and undergoing sentence in Central Jail-1, Hisar, for the offence under Section 376 (2) (g) of the Indian Penal Code, filed an application on 13.02.2017 seeking parole for her husband to enable him to arrange the resources to pay the fees.

Learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner submits that

the above application submitted by the wife of the writ petitioner on 13.02.2017 has not been disposed of by the authorities concerned.

In view of the above, the writ petition stands disposed of with a direction to the respondents to dispose of the above application submitted by the wife of the writ petitioner within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of this order.
