By way of filing the instant petition directions are sought to the official respondents to release the petitioner on parole so as to facilitate him to attend the Tehrawin and Solwin ceremonies of his father who had expired on 04.01.2017.

After issuing notice of motion, a short reply by way of an affidavit of the Superintendent, District Jail, Jhajjar, has been filed in Court and the same is taken on record. Copy has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner.

With the consent of the counsel for the parties, the main petition is taken up for final disposal today itself.

It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner is a convict in relation to an FIR No.200 dated 27.06.2000, under Sections 392/394/398 of Indian Penal Code, Police Station City Hansi vide judgment dated 21.10.2003 recorded by the trial Court and has been sentenced to undergo

A perusal of the reply as also the report of the Superintendent of Police, Hisar at Annexure P-3 would reflect that the prayer for parole of the petitioner is being opposed primarily on the ground that his antecedents are not clean and he is involved in as many as 49 criminal cases. Details of 03 other cases in which the petitioner stands convicted have been furnished in the reply itself.

Be that as it may the fact as regards the petitioner having lost his father on 04.01.2017 has been duly verified.

In the considered view of this Court, ends of justice would be met if the petitioner is permitted to be taken under police custody itself to facilitate the participation of the petitioner in the final religious ceremony in relation to the unfortunate demise of his father which is stated to be held on 19.01.2017.

Petition is disposed of.
