Petitioner-convict-Mukesh alias Guddu has filed the present writ petition seeking a direction to the 2nd respondent to decide the application submitted by him seeking parole for house repair.

An elaborate reply was filed.

We went through the reply submitted by the 3rd respondent-Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar. In paragraphs 7 and 8 of the preliminary submissions found as part of the reply, it has been contended that reminder has been sent to the 4th respondent-District Magistrate, Bhagpat, Uttar Pradesh, seeking a clear report as to whether he recommends or declines to recommend for the release of the petitioner on parole. We went through the report submitted by the 4th respondent in which he has taken a clear stand.

The 2nd respondent-Divisional Commissioner, Ambala Range, Ambala, is directed to pass a final order on the plea submitted by the applicant seeking parole for house repair, within 15 days from the date of this order based on the report already submitted by the 4th respondent as we

find that the application submitted by the petitioner as early as on 19.05.2016 is pending disposal at the hands of the 2nd respondent in spite of a clear report submitted by the 4th respondent as early as on 03.06.2016.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
