The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for extension of parole already granted vide order dated 16.12.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was to surrender on 28.03.2017 after availing parole of 28 days. Wife of the petitioner died on 26.03.2017 and her last rites are to be performed on 07.04.2017.

Notice of motion in the present case was issued for today and in the meanwhile parole was extended on the same terms and conditions.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Ram Chand admitted the factum of death of wife of the petitioner on 26.03.2017 and the date of her performing last rites on 07.04.2017.

In view of above, period of parole is extended upto 08.04.2017. The extension shall be considered under Section 3(1)(a) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962. The conditions while granting the parole would remain the same.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
