The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section (1) (a) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent/State to grant interim bail/emergency parole/furlough for four weeks so as to enable the petitioner to attend the Tehravi/Bhog Ceremony on 31.03.2017 and perform other rites and rituals of his uncle (Tau) who had died on 21.03.2017.

2. Reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Satvinder Kumar, Superintendent, District Jail, Bhiwani on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

3. On the basis of the aforesaid reply, learned State counsel submitted that the petitioner had not approached the Superintendent, District Jail, Bhiwani for the relief sought in the present petition.

4. After hearing learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the Tehravi/Bhog Ceremony of the uncle (Tau) of the petitioner is fixed for 31.03.2017, the petitioner is ordered to be taken to the place in police custody to attend the Tehravi/Bhog Ceremony of his uncle (Tau) by the Jail authorities and brought back to the Jail after the conclusion of the said ceremony.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
