FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel has submitted report of Station House Officer Bahav Wala dated 04.04.2017 along with death certificate and statements by way of panchyatnama of the residents.

In view of the stand of the State that father of the petitioner namely Mandar Singh has expired on 29.03.2017 and whose last rites and ceremonies were performed on the same day and in view of the contentions of two sides that the petitioner being the son of the deceased his presence at the time of Bhog ceremony i.e. on 09.04.2017 is very much essential in view of the rituals and customs of the societal requirements.

In the light of these submissions and in the interest of justice the petitioner is granted parole for a period of four days with effect from 08.04.2017 to 11.04.2017 subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the

sum of ₹2.00 lac with two sureties each of the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa /Duty Magistrate and he shall surrender before the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur, on 12.04.2017 at 10.00 a.m.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
