Reply by way of an affidavit of D.K.Bhardwaj, HPS, Additional Superintendent of Police, Sonipat, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4, which discloses that the detenues (brick kiln workers) were present at the brick kiln, when Warrant Officer visited the brick kiln. The owner of the brick kiln, who was called on the spot telephonically, made a statement that he had no objection if the alleged detenues leave the brick kiln. All the detenues along with their belongings left the brick kiln for their respective abodes on a canter bearing Registration No.HR-69A-4576.

In view of the above position, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous. The same is accordingly dismissed.
