Learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Madan Lal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamunanagar-1 on behalf of respondent No.1, which is duly accompanied with supporting documents, today in the Court. Same are taken on record.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the two sides and the admitted stand of the State that father of petitioner-Shokat Ali, namely, Gulam Rasuldar is reported to have expired on 1st of April, 2017 on account of his hospitalization due to illness at Indus International Hospital, Derabassi (Mohali) and thereafter whose cremation was undertaken and it is the stand of the State that the *Superde-khak*, is to be solemnized on 20th April, 2017.

Keeping in view the fact that being a son, presence of the

petitioner is very much essential at the last rites and ceremonies in view of the prevalent customs and rituals and thus, in the interest of justice taking a lenient view into the matter, it would be sub-serve the ends of justice if the petitioner is granted parole for a period of 03 days with effect from 19th April, 2017 to 21st April, 2017 subject to furnishing of personal bonds for an amount of ₹ 2.00 lacs with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar and the petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar on 22nd April, 2017 at 10.00 a.m.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly
