ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking a direction to release him on parole/interim bail for a period of three weeks on account of marriage of his daughter.

The petitioner has been convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment in FIR No.RC7(S)/96-SIU.V, dated 29.10.1996, under Section 120-B read with 302, 302 read with Section 34 IPC and 25/27 of Arms Act, Police Station SIU.V/SIC.II/CBI/N. Delhi. The prayer of the petitioner for parole to enable him to attend the marriage of his daughter has been rejected by the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala vide order dated 13.12.2016. It is apparent from perusal of the order dated 13.12.2016 (Annexure P-2) that the petitioner had earlier jumped parole w.e.f. 01.08.2007 to 13.02.2015. It is also stated in the order that parole case of the petitioner cannot be initiated before 12.02.2017. The petitioner had earlier absconded for a period of over 08 years earlier after his release on parole.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to the marriage invitation card wherein it is stated that the marriage of daughter of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 17.01.2017.

The petitioner is stated to be the only male member in his family. It would be in the interest of justice, if the petitioner is permitted to perform the ceremonies for the marriage of his daughter. In view of his past conduct, it is necessary that the petitioner is taken in police custody for the marriage.

Therefore, respondent No.2 is directed to send the petitioner from Central Jail, Ambala at 10.00 a.m. on 16.01.2017 to his village Khardauni, Police Station Inchauli, District Meerut in police custody (without handcuffs) and he will be brought back to Central Jail, Ambala by 05.00 p.m. on 18.01.2017.

The petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
