Today, status report by way of affidavit of Shri Kuldeep Singh Chahal, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, has been filed in Court and the same is taken on record. In the said affidavit, it is stated that in this case, accused Jaspal Singh as well as deteneu Anshu have been recovered from Mussorie, District Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh. Jaspal Singh has been arrested in FIR No. 21, dated 27.1.2017, registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar. It is further stated that the boy was produced before the Duty Magistrate and he was sent to Juvenile Home, Hoshiarpur. The girl Anshu was produced before the Illaqa Magistrate, where her statement was recorded, in which she stated that she does not want to go with her parents. Therefore, she has been sent to Nari Niketan i.e. Vaneeta Gandhi Ashram, Jalandhar.

Since the deteneu has been recovered, therefore, the petition

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becomes infructuous and is disposed of as such. A direction is issued to the Illaqa Magistrate, Mohali, to expeditiously decide the matter regarding custody of Anshu and ensure that she is not detained in Nari Niketan i.e. Vaneeta Gandhi Ashram, Jalandhar, for longer or indefinite period.
