JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner has retired on 30.06.2015 from the rank of Kanungo on attaining the age of superannuation (58 years) with the Department of Revenue, Punjab. He has been granted extension in service for two years ending on 30.06.2017.

By filing the present writ petition he has laid challenge to the order dated 7.6.2016 (P-2) whereby three of his junior Kanungos have been granted the current duty charge of the promotional post of Naib Tehsildar in Patiala Division by ignoring the claim of the petitioner.

Upon notice reply has been filed wherein it is stated that as per the instructions dated 30.10.2015 (R-1), persons during the extended period

Faced with this situation learned Counsel for the petitioner is unable to address any meaningful arguments.

In view of the above, present petition is hereby dismissed.
