Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Sarabjit Singh, PPS, DSP Dakha, District Ludhiana whereby police has taken a stand that Malkit Singh, uncle of the petitioner Sucha Singh, has been arrested on 11.04.2017 in a case bearing FIR No.78 dated 11.04.2017 under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and that he is already facing five other criminal cases, two under the NDPS Act and three under Sections 307/353/188 etc. IPC, which could not be displaced by the learned counsel representing the petitioner.

In the light of the same, since there has been legal recourse adopted by the respondent/State, thus nothing survives in this criminal writ petition which stands dismissed accordingly.
