An email received from Mr.Jaspal Singh Manjhpur, Advocate was treated as habeas corpus petition. The advocate had informed this Court that he was informed by Harpreet Kaur that her husband Raj Singh @ Shehna and his friend Manjinder Singh have been picked up by the police from their house along with some other articles. Email was received on 23.4.2017 at midnight.

Reply of the State shows that on 23.4.2017 on receipt of secret information a case under Sections 10, 11, 13 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act was registered at Police Station Basti Jodhewal, Ludhiana against said Manjinder Singh at about 8. p.m. Manjinder Singh was arrested at 11.00 p.m. and a revolver of .315 bore, 2 live cartridges and a motorcycle Hero Honda Splendor Plus bearing registration no.PB-11-BB-6634 were recovered. Father of

Manjinder Singh was informed about his arrest. Subsequently, police remand was obtained and now the said Manjinder Singh is in judicial custody. Police denied the arrest of Raj Singh @ Shehna.

It comes out that none of the family members of the said two persons namely, Manjinder Singh and Raj Singh @ Shehna have made any direct complaint to this Court. It was only an advocate who sent an email at midnight to this Court. The police claims that Manjinder Singh was arrested after registration of FIR.

It being so, no further action in the matter is required.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
