INDERJIT SINGH, J.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C. read with Section 3(1)(c) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temp. Release) Act, 1988, to issue direction to the respondents to decide the pending agriculture parole application which was submitted by the respondent No.3 to respondent Nos.2 and 4 on 25.02.2017, but the same has not been decided till date and further to release the petitioner on agriculture parole for six weeks to enable him to execute necessary agriculture work and plough his fields.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer that the agriculture parole application given by the petitioner may be decided expeditiously.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In view of the fact that the application for parole has already been filed by the petitioner before the competent authority, therefore, the competent authority is directed to decide the same expeditiously, preferably within 45 days.
