M.M.S. BEDI, JUDGE (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed the present petition for two reliefs, i.e. for cancellation of the arms licence of respondent No.4 alleged to have been obtained by suppressing the material information and for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

The authorities competent under law have considered the facts and circumstances of the case and recommended that the arms licence of respondent No.4 does not deserve to be cancelled.

So far as other prayer of the petitioner for protection of life

and liberty is concerned, it is observed that he has claimed that he is a resident of Canada and he has got threat to his life at the hands of respondent No.4 on account of he, being involved in few cases of assault and misappropriation.

This petition is disposed of with an observation that in case of any threat perception, it will be open to the petitioner to submit a representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, who will consider the said application and depending upon the threat perception to take appropriate decision by considering the application expeditiously.
