Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 15.05.2017, an affidavit of the grandfather of the petitioner, namely Inderjeet Singh, who was ordered to be impleaded as respondent no.5 vide the aforesaid order, has been filed in Court today, by his brother-in-law and attorney Sh. Ashok Kumar, in whose favour a special power of attorney, executed by Inderjeet Singh, has also been produced in Court.

As per the said affidavit, Inderjit Singh, states that the petitioner, i.e. his granddaughter, Harmanpreet Kaur, is residing with him and he would be responsible for her future and needs, but she would not be entitled to any share in his property, as she has already received her share from his property.

The mother (Paramjit Kaur) of the petitioner, is also stated to be present in Court, identified by the petitioner herself.

She submits that she would have nothing further to say as to

where the petitioner wishes to reside in view of the fact that the petitioner is above the age of 18 years.

The petitioner submits that she would continue to reside with her grandfather.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, the petitioner already being with her grandfather.
