Short affidavit of Lalit Kohli, PPS, Deputy Superintendent
Central Jail, Jalandhar at Kapurthala filed by learned State counsel,
today in Court, is taken on record.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Paras 3 and 4 of the said short affidavit read thus:-

“3. It is submitted that one another Production warrant was received in this office from Ld. Court of Ms Rajwant Kaur SDJM Phagwara in case FIR No.170 dated 22.11.2016 U/s 379 IPC PS GRP Jalandhar at Phagwara in which a note was made on production warrant by the Ld. Court that the accused is in custody in this case.

4. It is submitted that accused Ravi Kumar s/o Joginder Pal was released on bail in case FIR No.16 dated 25.02.2017 U/s 411/ 482/ 34 IPC PS Cantt Jalandhar by the order of Ld. Court of Sh. Balkar Singh Judicial Magistrate Ist Class Jalandhar on 06.03.2017 and was detained in jail in case FIR No.170 dated 22.11.2016 U/s

379 IPC PS GRP Jalandhar at Phagwara being custody in this pending case.”

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with liberty in favour of the petitioner to take such steps as are available in law.
