1. In the instant writ petition, petitioner has sought for direction to the respondents to consider his name for appointment on compassionate ground with reference to policy decision of the respondent-Bank.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that petitioner is not entitled for compassionate appointment as per the policy. However, petitioner and legal heirs of deceased employee – Karam Singh are entitled for ex-gratia benefits.

3. In view of above submissions made by counsel for the respondents, petitioner and legal heirs of late Sh. Karam Singh are permitted to make necessary application for ex-gratia to the respondent-Bank, within a period of four weeks from today. The concerned

respondent is hereby directed to consider the claim of the petitioner and legal heirs of late Sh. Karam Singh for ex-gratia and extend ex-gratia benefits within a period of three months from the date of receipt of application.

4. With the above observation, instant writ petition stands disposed of .
