Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that father of the petitioner was operated and discharged from the hospital on 8.5.2017. His condition is still precarious and he is on bed. Learned State counsel submits that on enquiry from neighbours, it has been found that father of petitioner has been operated and require someone to look after.

In view of the submission of the counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel, this petition is disposed of with direction to

respondents No.2 and 3 to provide three weeks parole to the petitioner subject to his complying with direction as given by the competent authority.
