In this Criminal Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 sub sections (1)(a) and Section 7 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, the petitioner is seeking four weeks' parole for treatment of his wife.

2. Case called twice. None has come present on behalf of the petitioner.

3. The petitioner is undergoing sentence for life in case FIR No. 423 dated 02.11.2013 under Sections 302 and 210 IPC, registered at Police Station Sampla (Rohtak) vide judgment and order dated 21.03.2016 and 29.03.2016, respectively, by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rohtak.

4. Appeal bearing Criminal Appeal No. 520-DB of 2016 against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence is pending before this Court.

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5. It is prayed in the writ petition that the petitioner be granted parole for a period of four weeks' for treatment of his wife. However, on careful perusal of the petition, we find that not even single document has been produced on record with regard to the ailment of the wife of the petitioner.

6. In view thereof, we are not inclined to grant parole to the petitioner. Consequently the petition is dismissed.
