Report filed and is taken on record. A complaint by Palo wife of Makhan Ram was received in the office of Chief Justice of this Court which was treated as criminal writ petition and notice of motion was issued to the State.

Complainant has alleged that on 27.4.2017, police of SBS Nagar forcibly entered her house and picked up her husband.

In the report filed by the learned State counsel, it is mentioned that 12 cases have been registered against Makhan Ram, the details of which have been given in para. 2 of the reply. Four cases have been registered against complainant-Palo. Out of above 16 cases, 14 have been registered for offence punishable under NDPS Act and the first case against Makhan Ram was registered in the year 1999. This shows that the application fled by Palo is a sort preemptive action taken by her to cover

her unlawful activities. Statement of Makhan Ram has also been attached with the report wherein he has stated that he was not picked up by the police.

Keeping in view the above facts, I find no reason to take any further action on the complaint and the same is ordered to be filed.
