FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The alleged detainee Col. Sher Singh (Retired) has been produced on wheelchair today before this Court accompanied by respondent No.3 Rajvir Singh, who has been identified by the petitioner as well as Ranvir Singh, Advocate, son of the petitioner, who has appeared before this Court of his own.

During the course of interaction with the petitioner and alleged detainee Col. Sher Singh it is apparent that though both are old aged persons but are mentally alert and having sufficient understanding of the things. Col. Sher Singh has made statement that he has divided his ancestral

property between his sons and the same has been mutated in their names and he has also executed a Will of the house in which he is presently residing and has given each of his son equal share. Ranvir Singh, Advocate who also happens to be his son submitted that inadvertently particulars of his parentage has been wrongly mentioned which is accepted by petitioner and her husband. Petitioner Chawli Devi has made statement that due to some misunderstanding she has moved the petition and wants to withdraw the same and even Col. Sher Singh has accepted that he has not been detained by anybody nor has been kept in illegal custody by anyone. On the statement of the petitioner Chawli Devi that she wishes to withdraw the present petition, the present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
