Report of the Warrant Officer has been received. In his report, Warrant Officer has stated that he had visited Police Post, Baltana on 17.5.2017 where Amarpal son of Dharamvir Singh was found standing in the reporting room of the police post. On inquiry, Headconstable Bhushan Kumar, Duty Officer apprised Warrant Officer that the detainee had been called on that day in connection with the investigation of case bearing FIR No.186 dated 14.5.2017 registered for offence punishable under Section 379 IPC.

On perusal of the said FIR, it was found that the same had been registered against unknown persons. As detainee Amarpal was not required by the police in any case, he was allowed to go from the police post which he left along with his brother.

In view of the report of Warrant Officer, no further action is

required in this petition. However, the petitioner and the detenue shall be at liberty to avail other legal remedies available to him.
