Prayer in this criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to grant emergency parole to the petitioner for a period of 28 days w.e.f. 01.06.2017 to 28.06.2017.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced a medical certificate of the mother of the petitioner along with the original bills of the medicines to be taken by her in Court today. The same are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present criminal writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned Jail Superintendent.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
